## Dear Prospective Juror:

The Richland County Jury Commissioners have randomly drawn your name to serve as a Grand Juror in the Richland County Common Pleas Court. You are subject to call for a two-month period of time. It is unlikely that you will actually serve more than eight (8) days during your term of jury service.

JURY PAYMENT AND WORK EXCUSES: Jurors are paid for each day they actually serve. You will be paid after the end of the second month of service. The Courts will issue a work excuse to give your employer if you need one. An employer is prohibited from retaliating against an employee for serving on a jury. (R.C. 2313.18)

PARKING: Free parking is provided to jurors in the gravel parking lot at the corner of E. Luther Place and S. Adams, as well as, the last three rows of the lot at the corner of E. Second and S. Adams. Do not park at parking meters.

## **EXCUSE FROM JURY DUTY:**

A person is disqualified from jury service if the person:

- A. is less than 18 years old, or
- B. is not a citizen of the United States, or
- C. is not a resident of Richland County, or
- D. is unable to communicate in the English language, or
- E. has been convicted of a felony and has not had civil rights restored.

A person may be excused from jury service on request if the person:

- A. has served as a juror within the past 24 months, or
- B. is physically unable to serve (requires a doctor's excuse), or
- C. has a spouse who has recently died or is dangerously ill (requires a doctor's excuse), or
- D. you are a caregiver for a sick, aged or infirm dependent (requires a doctor's excuse).

If you think you have a valid reason for not serving as a juror, explain your reason in <u>writing</u> and send it in with your juror inform ation form along with any required documentation. <u>PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO APPEAR</u>: Persons who fail to appear for jury service after being notified may be fined up to \$500.00 and otherwise punished for contempt of court.

## **GRAND JUROR QUESTIONNAIRE**

FAILURE TO RETURN THE QUESTIONNAIRE OR ANSWER IT COMPELTELY AND HONESTLY COULD RESULT IN CONTEMPT OF COURT CHARGES.
